MTSS Fidelity Rubric Target Areas:

- 4b Secondary-Level Intervention (Tier II)
 - Evidence-Based Intervention All secondary-level interventions are evidence based in content areas and grade levels where they are available.
 - Complements Core Instruction- Secondary-level intervention is well aligned with core instruction and incorporates foundational skills that support the learning objectives of core instruction.
 - Instructional Characteristics All three of the following conditions are met: (1) interventions are standardized; (2) secondary-level interventions are led by staff trained in the intervention according to developer requirements; and (3) group size and dosage are optimal (according to research) for the age and needs of students.
 - Addition to Primary Secondary-level interventions supplement core instruction
- **5d Schedules.** School wide schedules are aligned to support multiple levels of intervention based on student need; adequate additional time is built in for interventions
- **6a Fidelity**. Both of the following conditions are met: (1) procedures are in place to monitor the fidelity of implementation of the core curriculum and secondary and intensive interventions...
