





ACE Score and Ever Addicted to Drugs




The ACE Score and the Prevalence of Attempted Suicide





Adverse Childhood Experiences have a strong influence on common health and social problems:

-adolescent health -reproductive health -smoking -obesity -alcohol abuse -illicit drug abuse -sexual behavior -mental health risk of violence and revictimization -stability of relationships -performance in the workforce

ACEs Increase the Risk for Chronic Diseases

- Heart disease
- Chronic lung disease
- Stroke
- Diabetes
- Cancer

- Lung cancer
- Liver disease
- Suicide
- Injuries
- HIV and STDs
- -Autoimmune diseases
- -Premature mortality



Among Elementary Students with 3 or more ACEs The Risk of Multiple Problems Increase

Academic failure: 3 times

Poor Health: 4 times

Severe Attendance Problems: 5 times

-Severe Behavior Problems: 6 times




Average High School Classroom


The Prison Pipeline








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Power of the ACE Study? -A Common Language -And Conceptual Framework

- ACEs are common
- ACEs are highly interrelated
- ACEs "pile up" and have a cumulative impact (ACE Score)
- ACEs account for a large percentage of health and social problems
- Biologic Understanding (Neuroscience and Epigenetics)


