**SIMR:** The percentage of third grade students with disabilities will increase their state test reading proficiency from 23.63% in 2017-18 to 29.00% in 2025-26.

## 1. DBI Implementation Checklist (Revised for 2023-24)

What? Checklist to measure DBI implementation before and after the DBI training

**Why?** To determine the extent to which school personnel are implementing the essential components of school-level implementation of data-based individualization for students who need intensive intervention.

Who? Participating teachers and other school staff (if appropriate) complete one checklist as a team per collection.

When? Fall 2023: Complete by December 1, 2023. Spring 2024: Complete between May 1-15, 2024
